Gift Card Scam Alert:

Several local churches have reported a recent internet scam. Thieves will send an email from an address closely resembling that of the church's clergy or other leader, asking parishioners to buy gift cards (supposedly for charitable purposes), then to send the card activation number by reply email. The sender will insist that the need is urgent; scammers will often include names and other details about the church leader and the parishioner to make the request seem legitimate. Do not ever respond to such a request without contacting the clergy or lay leader in person or by phone. There is very little recourse if the scammer cashes out the card.

Registration is open for Groundlings! Groundlings is a multi-generational summer ministry hosted by Los Altos UMC and St. Gregory's. We fill our days with bible study, crafts, recreation, family time, and service
