Feed My Lambs & Food Bank Needs:

Our parish feeding programs need your help!

- **Feed My Lambs** has the following needs:
- **Our egg cups are overflowing!!! We need one or 2 people to switch from eggs to cookies, please! We had too many eggs and barely enough cookies. Thanks!**
 - **Hardboiled Eggs** -- We need 100 hardboiled eggs each month. Hardboiled eggs can be dropped off at the Parish Office on two occasions: Wednesday, August 4 from 10am – 12pm or on Friday, August 6 from 11am to 3pm. If these times do not work, contact Tamera and she will arrange a convenient time to meet you at the church.
 - **Homemade Cookies** -- Any homemade cookies can be brought to church on Wednesday, August 4 from 10am –

12pm or on Thursday, August 5 at 11am so they can be sorted and bagged. If these times do not work, contact Tamera and she will arrange a convenient time to meet you at the church.

- **Clothing and Comfort Items** -- PLEASE NO WOMEN'S CLOTHES for now. They always need underwear, but no other women's clothing, please. We need towels, wash cloths, men's pants and shorts (sizes 32-38), men's shoes (sizes 10-14), backpacks, and blankets.
- **Volunteers** -- We need volunteers to help with lunch preparations on the Friday before the first Saturday of the month August 6 (2pm), and to help work at St. Luke's on the first Saturday of the month August 7 (7 to 9:30am). Contact Tamera if you are interested in helping.
